Local restrictions – outside of London

Outside of London there are numerous other restrictions for heavy goods vehicles both in town centres and rural areas of outstanding natural beauty. Drivers should follow the special signs guiding them through or around areas where restrictions are in place.

Scottish LEZs in Aberdeen, Dundee, Edinburgh, Glasgow all became enforceable by Spring 2024. Vehicles must be Euro 6 to enter the zones. There is no pre-registration process therefore ALL owners of foreign vehicles who enter the zones will receive a penalty notice letter, which will need responding to with the evidence proving the Euro rating of the vehicle to enable a retraction of the penalty to be given. LONDON - Direct Vision Standard (DVS) Permit & Safety Permit - Required for all vehicles over 12tns entering the Greater London area https://tfl.gov.uk/info-for/deliveries-in-london/delivering-safely/direct-vision-in-heavy-goodsvehicles

Direct Vision Standard requirements in London have changed.
